ONE VOICE FOR VOLUSIA OVERVIEW

One Voice for Volusia celebrated 23 years of service to the community. With a refined strategic plan, we used a two-prong approach to focus on building capacity among community providers and expanding direct universal prevention efforts to address individual, family, and community risk factors and enhance protective factors. Continuing activities included:

- One Voice for Volusia Coalition meetings
- All Abilities and thrive by five Collaborative meetings
- Community Connector and social media campaigns
- Social media toolkit maintenance
- Leadership and chairing committees, including Substance Use Disorder Sub-committee, Volusia DJJ Council, Community Health Improvement Plan (CHIP) and Community Health Needs Assessment (CHNA) process
- Connecting community providers and members with resources
- Environmental scans of pharmacies and alcohol outlets
- Safe storage and disposal training
- Deterra distribution
- Take Back Days and advertisement of safe disposal methods, including permanent drop boxes
- Community event attendance and guest speaking
- Narcan distribution on a small scale
- Contextual Leadership One-day Intensives and Five-week Series
- Annual Health & Human Services Summit

One Voice for Volusia expanded their reach in multiple ways. New strategies included:

One Voice for Volusia started the 2023-2024 fiscal year strong with great feedback on the Needs Assessment, Logic Model, and Strategic Planning process for the next three years. A core focus of the strategy involved youth, and One Voice for Volusia dedicated time to obtaining feedback from community providers, partners, parents/caregivers, and youth. The public outcry on youth vaping did replace much of the efforts around youth, but the new focus allowed One Voice for Volusia to connect with schools and students through focus groups and conversations that informed all efforts.
